APPLICATION INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in applying for membership with the Jefferson-Como Fire Protection District (herein after referred to as JCFPD). The following application has been prepared in compliance with TITLE SEVEN OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT of 1964 and TITLE ONE of THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT of 1992.

All of the following forms must be completed and submitted before an oral interview will be scheduled.

1. Membership Application Form – Completed Form – (Note: Applicant must be a minimum of twenty one (21) years of age.)
2. Physical Examination Form - *A physician must complete the accompanying physical examination form. The date of applicant's most recent complete physical exam can be within one year of the date of application.
3. Driver and Criminal Background Information Form- *Applicant must provide a current Colorado Driver's License, driving history and agree to a criminal background check. This form must be signed giving the proper entities the authority to release any requested information to Jefferson-Como Fire Protection District upon request. Applicant must be a minimum of twenty one (21) years of age.
4. Statement of Vehicle Insurance Form - *When applicant uses a personal vehicle to respond to emergency calls, training or to conduct business for The District, the applicant will carry current liability vehicle insurance. Proof of valid insurance coverage must be attached to this form and is required at all times by Jefferson-Como Fire Protection District.
5. Acknowledgement of Risks/ Agreement to Return All Equipment and/or Gear/ Agreement to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Jefferson-Como Fire Protection District Form.
6. Volunteer Fire Service History Form

(*) Additional information will be found on the named form.

All of the above information is mandatory before a decision can be reached regarding the eligibility of an applicant to become a Probationary Member of the Jefferson-Como Fire District. All of the requested information is job related or mandated by law.

Upon submitting all of the application information, the applicant will be scheduled for an oral interview with an Oral Board, three (3) current members of the JCFPD. This interview will assure that all requirements have been met. The Oral Board will then have thirty, (30) days to accept or deny an application for Probationary Membership.
