

House Bill 18-1051

Concerning Statutory Provisions enacted to Promote the Extinguishment of Unattended Fire

30-15-201 Penalty for leaving campfire unattended.

- (I) Fails to reasonably attend the Campfire at all times
- (II) Fails to Thoroughly extinguish the campfire before leaving the site

b (I) A person who commits the offense of leaving a campfire unattended commits a **Class 2 Petty Offense** and, upon conviction of the offence shall be punished by a fine of **Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.**

- (II) A Person who commits the offense of leaving a campfire unattended where the campfire is located in a Forested or Grassland area commits a **Class 3 Misdemeanor** and upon conviction of the offense, shall be punished by a **Minimum sentence of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollar** fine up to **Maximum sentence of six (6) months imprisonment of a Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) dollar fine, or both.**

33-15-106. Fires. (1) On any property under the control of the division, it is unlawful for any person to:

- (a) Start or Maintain a fire of he or she knowingly or recklessly fails to reasonably attend the fire at all times or fails to thoroughly extinguish the fire before leaving the Site;
- (III) (a) Any person who violate Subsection (1) (a) of this section is guilty of a Class 3 Misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a **Minimum sentence of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollar** fine up to **Maximum sentence of six (6) months imprisonment of a Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) dollar fine, or both.**
